Wednesday March the 14th
 this day commences with light breeze from NE to E
 with hazy weather Mid part calm later part
 light breeze from E and ends the day
 Lat 44 02 Long 122 20 W

Thursday March the 15th
 this day commences with moderate breeze from
 E NE and later part fine breeze from W E
 with hazy weather thus ends the day
 Lat 45 44 Long 130 38 W

Friday March the 16th
 this day commences with fine breeze from NE
 Mid and later parts from W fine weather
 thus ends the day
 Lat 47 03 Long 126 51 W Course E by S

Saturday March 17th
 this day commences with strong breeze from
 W saw a frigate, caught a Porpoise Mid part
 strong from W W hauled the main & fore sail
 main, fore and aft, Double reefed fore sail later
 part moderated all sail out took in the West boat
 Lat 48 20 Long 122 04 W Course E by S

Sunday March the 18th
 this day commences with strong breeze, thick fog
 and rain from W W Mid and later part strong
 breeze from W W at 8 PM Double reefed the
 fore sail hauled the main sail parted the
 main top sail sheet and ends the day
 Lat by account 48 40 Long 115 01 W E by S

Monday March the 19th
 this day commences with a moderate gale from
 W W Mid part smart gale running under
 closed reefed main top sail at 6 PM set as reefed fore
 sail and closed reefed fore top sail at 8 PM the wind
 hauled to W W later part moderating and running
 no observations thus ends the day
 Lat by account 49 45 Long 113 30 W Course E by S

Tuesday March the 20th
 this day commences with fine breeze from
 W W clearing off made all sail, Mid part a
 moderate gale from W W later part hauled to W W with
 rain but by Doub 11 45 40 W
 Lat 50 52 Long 109 45 W Course E by S

Wednesday March the 21st
 this day commences with light breeze from W W
 with rain at 2 PM hauled to W W at 6 PM
 the Lat by observation of the Star Sirius was 50 12 S
 Mid and later part strong breeze from W to
 W W thus ends the day

Lat 51 57 S Long 106 12 W Course E by S
 Thursday March the 22nd

this day commences with strong breeze from
 W W with hazy weather Mid and later part
 strong from W W with smart squalls
 and ends the day

Lat 52 51 S Long 101 05 W Course E by S

Friday March the 23rd
 this day commences with strong breeze from W with
 smart squalls, Mid and later part from
 W W to W W and ends the day

Lat 53 36 S Long 95 30 W Course E by S

Saturday March the 24th
 this day commences with strong breeze from
 W W at 2 PM took in the main top galent sail
 and Double reefed the fore sail at 6 PM the
 wind hauled W turned the reef out, the Mid sail
 Mid and later part strong breeze with
 smart squalls from W
 and ends the day

Lat 54 09 S Long 90 25 W Course E by S

Sunday March the 25th
 this day commences with fine breeze and
 fine weather from W opened two 300 of Reef
 Mid and later part from W to W
 and fine weather thus ends the day
