Monday April the 16

This day commences with moderate breezes from S.W. at 6 P.M. strong from S. Mid part the same later part from S.E. with thick and cloudy weather no observations this ends the day
Lat 30 25 N Long 43 40 W Course N.W. by E

Tuesday April the 17

This day commences with strong breezes from S.E. opened a pack of ice at 5 P.M. Double reefed topsails Mid part the same later part at 6 P.M. from E to W with heavy rain storm at noon more moderate this ends the day

Lat by the 25 04 N Long 41 00 W Course N.E. by N
Wednesday April the 18

This day commences with strong breezes from S.W. Mid and later parts from N.W. W. Saw to Briggs cloudy weather no observation this ends the day

Lat by the 28 10 N Long 45 40 W Course N.E. by E

Thursday April the 19
This day commences with moderate breezes from N.W. at 6 P.M. S.W. with rain Mid and later parts the same and so ends the day

Lat by the 27 00 N Long 44 00 W Course N.E.

Friday April the 20
This day commences with fine breezes from S. Mid and later parts from S.E. thick and cloudy weather and so ends the day

Lat 23 52 N Long 42 15 W Course E.N.E.

Saturday April the 21
This day commences with fine breezes from S.E. Mid part from S.W. Later part the same with rain storm opened 1 bill of beef and one of Pork and so ends the day

Lat by the 24 41 N Long 40 10 W Course E.N.E.

Sunday April the 22
This day commences with strong breezes from S.E. at 4 P.M. 3 sails in sight Mid part from E later part from W and so ends the day

Lat 22 14 N Long 38 57 W Course N.W. by E

Monday day commences with light breezes from N.W. 5 sails in sight Mid part fine breezes from N.W. Later part the same with fine weather Eastline down Main and Mizen Rigging so ends the day
Lat 21 23 N Long 36 55 W Course N.W. by E

Tuesday April the 24

This day commences with fine breezes from N.W. W. Mid and later parts the same sent up the foretop galant brass and yard so ends the day

Lat 20 03 N Long 34 55 W Course N.E. by E
Wednesday April the 25

This day commences with moderate breezes from N.W. at 7 P.M. hauled to S. Mid and later part light breezes from S. to S.E. firing Rigging and so ends the day
Lat 18 15 N Long 34 20 W Course N.E. by N

Thursday April the 26

This day commences with light breezes from S.E. with squall from the Eastward five sails in sight Mid part calm later light from S. so ends the day
Lat 18 27 N Long 33 50 W Course N.E.

Friday April the 27

This day commences with light breezes from N.W. 5 sails in sight Mid part light breezes and calm from W later part from N.W. so ends the day

Lat 17 54 N Long 33 00 W Course E.N.E.

Saturday April 28

This day commences with light breeze from N.W. 3 sails in sight Mid and later part light breezes and fine weather from S. 2 brigs in sight this ends the day

Lat 16 55 N Long 32 50 W Course E.N.E.
