This day commences with light breezes from

same 3 sail in sight so ends the day

This day commences with light breezes from
S very fine weather mid and later part
light breeze and calm from S to S E
Lat 14 18 N so ends the day
Long 32 30 W Course N by E

Tuesday May the 1
This day commences with calm 3 sail in sight
Mid part light breezes from E later part
fine breezes from E

Lat 13 06 S Long 32 43 W Course N
Wednesday May the 2

This day commences with fine breezes from E
Trade Winds mid and later part the same
back out mid so ends the day
Lat 10 20 S Long 33 20 W Course N by W

Thursday May the 3
This day commences with fine breezes from E S E
Mid and later parts moderate breezes
from S S E overhauling and drying
some so ends the day

Lat 8 32 S Long 34 44 W Course N W
Friday May the 4

This day commences with light breezes from
S S E at 6 PM made Cape St Augustin
Mid and later parts the same opened
all of keep drying and bundling some
the lunch about 15 miles dist to the water

Lat 6 36 S Long 34 55 W Course N by W
Saturday May the 5

This day commences with fine breezes from S S E
passed a number of batmeran or fishing boats at
8 PM the lunch 12 miles dist Port Moya
later parts fine breezes from S E drying some
so ends the day

Lat 4 11 S Long 36 00 W Course N S W
This day commences with fine breezes from
S E mid and later parts the same
and so ends the day
Lat 1 31 S Long 36 25 W Course N by W

Monday May the 7
This day commences with fine breezes from
S E mid part light later part light and
calm at 7 PM saw a school of small sperm
whales at 8 lowered for them the harpoons and
Vest boats struck at noon got the whales to the
ship so ends the day

Lat 01 10 S Long 37 00 W Course N S W
Tuesday May the 8

This day commences with calm commences buting
at 5 PM finished buting 2 sails in sight
Mid and later parts light breezes and calm
from E drying so ends the day
Lat 10 11 S Long 36 59 W Course N

Wednesday May the 9
This day commences with light breezes from
N S E opened all of day and later mid and later
part light from N S E finished drying turned
at 2 PM so ends the day
Lat 04 44 S Long 37 21 W Course N W

Thursday May the 10
This day commences with light breezes from N S E

finished drying and bundling some mid
and later parts the same opening a new
cragack yard so ends the day
Lat 1 40 S Long 37 50 W Course N S W

Friday May the 11
This day commences with moderate breezes from
N S E mid and later fine breezes from
N S E making a craggack yard the
this ends the day
