Comms With a Light breeze from the N. W. Ship Came to Anchor off Cape East in Company With the Sgate and some Whales and Lowered for them latter part 3 Cones Came a Long Side a Trading

Friday July the 2

Comms With a Light breeze from the S. Ship Got to under Way and Went further in to the Land and Came to a Gain and sent a raft in shore for Water We Could not fill them and We started for the ship again and a Whale Came up right a head of the boats and the head Casted off and Went and struck him and Kill him Ship Got under Way and took the Whale a Long Side and run around the bluff for a Gun and Comms to Cutting him



Saturday July the 3

Comms With a Strong Gale from the S. Ship Lying to Anchor With 70 fathom of Chain out and the Westrop's Sgate or 3 Perkins Drag Sgate and Perkins had to Leave Could not hold on the Westrop's had a Cone from a Stern Watch employed in bailing and Scapen bone

Sunday July the 4

Comms With a Strong Gale from the S. Ship Still Lying to Anchor a bailing Watch employed in Scapen bone and Getting out Water latter

Monday July the 5

Comms With Strong breeze from the S. Ship Still a Lying to Anchor a bailing saw the Westrop's Got under Way and Work up under the Land latter part Got Done a bailing and broke one of the part and Stowed Down

Tuesday July the 6

Comms With a Strong breeze from the S. Ship Lying to Anchor sent two boats off a Whaling saw two Whales and seen the Indians haul a Whale a Shore latter part the Harmony and Metcomb and Parker Came to Anchor

Wednesday July the 7

Comms With a Strong breeze from the S. Ship Lying to Anchor sent two boats off a Whaling and the Old Man Went to the Settlement
