Wednesday September the 1

Comms With a Strong breeze from the W.N.W.
Ship steering E.S.E. With all sail set
At five p.m. Made Cape East and saw
a number of California Grays and one bowe
head and took in the Royal and Main topgal
sail and Suble reef the topsail and haul up
the fore sail and Main sail and Luff in
Shore and at 8 p.m. Came to Anchor off of ^{25 fath}
East Cape one Canoe came a Long Side Latter
part Got under way and run for St Lawrence
bay

Thursday Sept the 2

Comms With a Strong breeze from the N.W.
Ship steering S.E. Carrying Suble reef topsails At
two p.m. Made a round St Lawrence head and Work
in the bay saw one ship in sight Middle
part Winds haul to the W ship steering S. With
all sail set Latter part spoke the Wailua
With three Whales this season bands imploye
in Ship Duties Lat 64-19

Friday Sept the 3. Log 171-46

Comms With a Light breeze from the N.W.
Ship steering W.S.W. With all sail set
in Company With the Wailua bound for
the Plover bay Latter part Calm With fog
and rain saw the Gt gate bound off and the Victory
going to Anchor off the bay Watch imployed in
Working Ship

Saturday Sept the 4

Comms With a Light breeze from the N.W.
Ship heading N.W.E. Working up the bay in Company
With the Wailua At 2 p.m. Came to Anchor
of the sand spit and sent a raft a shore for water
Latter part blowing pretty fresh at the second
Anchor So and plenty of rain

Sunday Sept the 5

Comms With a Strong breeze from the N.W.
Ship lying to with both anchors a head With
thick hazy weather Middle part fine weather
Latter part the same bands imployed in getting
off water and heaving up the Starboard anchor
and stowing it away and some Canoes came a Long
Side

Monday Sept the 6

Comms With a Light breeze from the S
Ship lying to Anchor At 2 p.m. the
old man and 2 and third Mate Went a Gunny
up the bay Middle part Winds haul
to the N and E With rain Latter part
Calm With thick weather bands imployed in
Working off ship Sept the 7

Comms With a Light breeze from the S
Ship still lying to Anchor in Company With
the Wailua At 6 p.m. the old man Went
a Gunny had 4 Canoes a Long Side a Maiden for
some Deer
