and Courses Watch employed in fitting the fore
lights and so on Latter part Trades very light
Watch employed in Ship Duty

Comms With Light Winds from the S.E.
Ship heading S.E.W With Main topsail Set
Latter part Watch employed in fitting the rigging
and letting out Water

Friday Nov the 25

Comms With a Light breeze from the S.E.
With plenty of rain squalls At 8 p.m. took
in the Main topsail Latter part the same
Watch employed in Ship Duty

Saturday Nov the 26 Long

Comms With a Strong breeze from the E.S.E.
Ship Steering S by E With hole topsails Set
and plenty of rain squalls Watch employed in fitting
the rigging Latter part the same

Sunday Nov the 28

Comms With a Light breeze from the S.E.
Ship heading S.E.W With all Sail Set
Watch employed in fitting the foot rope and
lifts and painting the two boats over head Latter
part took in the fore and Mizen topsails



Monday Nov the 29 Long

Comms With a Strong breeze from the S.E.
Ship heading S.E.W a Carrying Main topsail
and flying jib Latter part Winds haul to the E.S.E.

At 9 A.M. saw two Ships at Anchor a Station
in bird shit from Jarvis Island a boat 31 N
Kauai a Live a Shore Ship Mary Roberson and the

Watch employed in fitting the rigging and painting

rigging Latter part a little rain
