Monday July the 11

Comms With a light breeze from the W
Ship heading N.W. with thick foggy
Weather at one p.m. it cleared off some
We saw a Ship and it set in thick
fog again made part of the light
Sails. Showing best from the same
A quarter Ship heading S off shore
Latter part heading in shore with
thick foggy Weather at 11 o'clock made
the land and saw the Antilla to the N

Tuesday July the 12

Comms With a strong breeze from the W & W
Ship heading N.W. in shore with thick
Weather at 3 p.m. saw the Antilla to
the N and went a board latter part
the same Watch employed in working
Ship off Plover Bay used a bow head

Wednesday July the 13

Comms With a strong breeze from the W & W
Ship heading S off shore with thick
fog at 6 p.m. Ship in the mouth
of Plover Bay steering in at 7 p.m. took
out again latter part fine clear weather
Ship came to anchor in 12 fathom in Plover Bay

Thursday July the 14

Comms With a light breeze from the W & W
Ship heading to anchor off Plover Bay
at 3 p.m. saw two bow heads and
sawers for them latter part fog
& Sails in sight one of them to
Anchor saw with the Allen Mars

Markes Bay

Friday July the 15

Comms With a light breeze from the W & W
Ship heading to anchor in Plover
Bay at 3 p.m. got under way and went out
Ship heading S latter part thick fog
Watch employed in sitting out water

Saturday July the 16

Comms With a light breeze from the W & W
With thick fog Ship heading N.W. in
to the land latter part the same
Watch employed in ship duty

Sunday July the 17

Comms With a light breeze from the S
Ship heading S.W. with cloudy weather
at 3 p.m. came with the Montic
and Good return and Rebo. Simms latter
part foggy to

off and at 3 p.m. came with the
Hon Howland & Whales this season
Rapt Edwards nothing Ship off Markes

 plenty of California Grays Ship off
St Lawrence Island
