Wednesday August the 3
Comms With a strong breeze from the N.W.
Ship heading N.E. with all sail set
the topsails and furl'd the mainsail
latter part made the sail 3 ship in
sight Lat 66-54 N

Thursday August the 4
Comms With Calms and fine clear
weather At 3 p.m. hauled with the
Magnolia 7 Whales this season and Crist
Whitell latter part light winds from
the N.W. Ship heading W.N.W. with thick
saine weather Lat 67-41 N

Friday Aug the 5 Long
Comms With a light breeze from the S.E.
Ship steering N.W. with all sail set
saw 2 sails in sight latter part winds from
the N.W. Ship heading N.W. with a little
fog Lat

Saturday Aug the 6 Long
Comms With a light breeze from the N.W.
Ship heading N.W. with some fog middle
part winds haul to the N. with thick fog
took in the light sails latter part
the same watch employed in getting
out water

August the 31 and 5 in the Lat 68-25
fore part of Sept got 6 more in
Shanter bay 1861 Clipper Ship
Ransomed Capt Dean

Sunday Aug the 7
Comms With a strong breeze from the N.
Ship heading W.N.W. with all sail set
with thick cloudy weather at 6 p.m. took
in the mainsail latter part Duble reef the
topsails and furl'd the 1st one sail in sight

Monday Aug the 8 Lat 69-04
Comms With a strong breeze from the N.
Ship heading E.N.E. under Duble reef topsails
with the 1st and mainsail furl'd saw one ship
in sight At 3 p.m. turn the reef out of
the topsails and let the 1st and mainsail middle
part winds haul to the N.W. Ship heading E
latter part winds haul to the N. with thick fog
Ship heading E.N.E. with all sail set breaking at
meat butter

Tuesday Aug the 9
Comms With a light breeze from the N.
Ship heading E.N.E. with thick fog At 6 p.m.
Clear off. latter part the same
saw three sails in sight Lat 69-05
Long



Wednesday Aug the 10
Comms With a light breeze from the N.
Ship heading E.N.E. with all sail set
3 sails in sight At 3 p.m. took Ship heading
W.N.W. middle part winds haul to the N.W.
took Ship heading N.E. latter part strong
breezes took in the light sail watch
employed in getting out water Lat 69-25
