Wednesday Oct the 5 Long
Comms With a strong breeze from the NNE
Ship Steering S.E. carrying all sail with
thick same weather At 3 P.M. took in
the brigs to gallant sail and carried away
the flying jib and at 6 P.M. double reef
the topsails latter part moderate made all
sail wind haul to the N.W. Lat 45-23
Long 165-23

Thursday Oct the 6
Comms With a light breeze from the N.W.
Ship Steering S.E. With all sail set
water employed in ship duty latter part
took the two boats down off the house
and Comms to fitting them Lat 43-35
Long 165-13 1/2

Friday Oct the 7
Comms With a calm at 3 P.M. set
a breeze from the S.E. Ship heading S.E. W
middle part took in the light sail
and double reef the topsail latter part
took in the fore and brigs topsail
hands employed in fitting the larboard
boat had plenty of rain Lat 40-02
