Ship steering S by a With all sail set
Watch employed in Lashing up the Spars
and finishing Washing off latter part
Winds haul to the NW Watch employed in
Washing Ship out Side

Comms With a light breeze from the NW
Ship heading S at 3 P.M. Winds haul to the

Comms With a Strong breeze from the NW
Ship steering S With all sail set

ships in light latter part Made short
Saw one bark Ship running down between
Marries and Mowee

Sunday Oct the 23

Comms With a Strong breeze from the NW
Ship steering S With all sail set
in Lifting the Anchors and Came off the
bow and at 2 P.M. Came to anchor in
Mowee and put bag in the hasp and
Ship George Washington of Wharfedale

Monday Oct the 24 1859

Comms With a light breeze from the NW
Ship steering S.E. in the Cape of Good Hope
at 10 A.M. Saw a steamer bound to
the Coast Watch employed in Ship
Duty
