this day light wind and fine weather saw nothing at 8 shorted sail latter part strong breeze and fair weather at 9 am saw porpoises 8 miles off the bow went about going quick fast a ship to the leeward showing I B. moody signal

this day strong breeze from West the whale in site at 4 pm boat struck got a tick then a long side set back and getting ready for cutting latter part strong breeze and cloudy cut in the two whale

at 12 noon spoke bark Midway with 600

this day strong breeze and cloudy clear away the sperm whale heard latter part strong breeze and cloudy boiling out

this day light wind and variable from West back 7 shorted sail latter part strong breeze and cloudy stood down the sail two sail in site

this day fresh breeze and squall saw nothing at 7 shorted sail latter part light wind and fair weather from WNW covered the broad between decks

this day light and fair weather from WNW at 8 shorted sail and finish covered the broad latter part light wind and fine weather saw nothing setting up lower rigging

this day light wind fine weather saw nothing shorted 11 sail from 11 am till 11 pm the cork with salt water latter part strong breeze and fair weather from SE finish starting water and filling the cork with salt water
