this day light wind from East to SE and fine weather & set up the head stay and givest and rove new lanards & Course West latter Part light rain and rain squall from S to NW

this day light wind and rain squall from South to S by E one sail in site latter Part strong breeze and rain squall at 2 hrs double reefed sail and 3 took in 5th spanker and all sail with thunder and light at 7

took in 4th sail & 5th sail close down all 5th sail hard squall of Wind and rain at 8 more

manovated set double reef sail to 4th sail and all 5th sail

Remarks on board Tuesday 28

this day strong breeze and fair weather all sail set saw nothing and sail in site bound to Eastward latter Part light wind and fine weather all sail set one of the stows parted to all 5th Mast rigging fitted it

this day light wind and fine weather from NW by heading to Westward rove new all 5th sail halgand latter Part light wind and fine weather from NW by to NW all sail set saw nothing stowed cargo of bread 168 gallon and started a cask of Molasses one barrel of Molasses was stove when it was packed by board of the ship in the cask

this day light wind from North and fine weather all sail set heading to the Westward latter Part light wind and fine weather wind from NE to East carpenter repair the stoves cooler at 12 noon heard for black fish got nothing

this day light wind and fine weather from NW heading to Westward at 6 PM saw black fish going to the Westward quick 4 sail during the day

latter Part strong breeze and smoky weather from S by E and sail set came NW by N

this day strong breeze and smoky weather from NW came NW by N at 2 PM made the land 10 of New Zealand for NW by N at 8 PM made the land made garboard stand in for light boat at 4 made the boat at 5 took pilot boat off for New Bedford at 8 PM came to Anchor a barrow Palmer Island and fired the sails &c
