fair weather. 9 am came to anchor
of Charl. Point light at 11 finished the

off at 3 Pm got under way and beating
out of the bay at 9 Pm pilot left of
the light boat. Lateral Bar strong, breeze from
north to NE. Stood the anchorage on the bar
and the chains to 60 fms.

this day strong breeze, and cloudy all day
not saw nothing wind South by East
R. C. Moring & N. E. Roberts both strayed
sick with Distemper off July for three days
Manning, Bravo, Gogo, and stop the
helo for githin sleep when they were

on the 10th. but they were little profit

nothing

calm one breeze in the forenoon
