Latter Part strong breezes and squalls from SE all sail set shoving the Decks and breaking bottom Decks and stowed over and in good shape Lat 34.40

this day strong breezes and squalls from SE the weather look bad and some swell from the NE all sail set heading to the Eastward Latter Part strong and fair weather all sail set in the Flying and repaired it and bent it a gin

Remarks on board Wednesday 20

this day from strong breezes and fair weather all sail set wind S by W and course ESE Latter Part light wind and fair weather rigging a new Mizzen stay out of it

Remarks on board Thursday 21

this day light wind and fine weather from S by W cause ESE Latter Part light wind and fine weather caulking Main spencer in to Mizzen stay set

Remarks on board Friday 22

this day light wind and fine weather from SE heading ENE Latter Part light and fine weather from SSE heading Eastward bent Mizzen stay set

this day light wind and fine weather from NE all heading Latter Part light wind and fair weather from South cause ESE breaking out the Board and flour and from the Board hole and cooper of it

this day strong breezes and squalls from S by W cause ESE finish cooper the Board and flour one sail in situ
Latter Part strong breezes and fair weather from NW cause ESE one sail in situ

this day strong breezes and squalls from NW cause ESE Latter Part strong breezes and fair weather mending S by W sail

Remarks on board Monday 25

this day light winds from SW to NE fair and rain squalls at 8 PM took in S by W sail the yard broke in two
Latter Part light and calm and raining squalls wind variable sent down S by W yard and maked a yard and a Mizzen sail fair

this day light wind and variable and squalls Latter Part strong breezes and thick rainy weather took in light sail
