this day strong breeze and fine weather from NE fitted rigging to all yards and put up the 1st Boat and nail her bottom over and painted the chutles by latter part strong breeze and fair weather from NE fitted the rigging all 3 yards and put new foot rope &

Remarks on board Tuesday 9th

this day strong breeze from NE finish M of sail on painter of Boat in side and line covers latter part strong breeze and fair weather from NE

fitted pedestal stump to M of sail yard and take down a boat from over head and getting her for rehabiling to sail in side

Remarks on board Wednesday 10th

this day strong breeze and fair weather from SE and fitted the pedestal stump to M of sail yard & put the boat over head latter part strong breeze and fine weather from SE fitted blocks &

this day strong breeze from NE painted Gas boat and one boat over head and fitted quarter block to M of sail yard & latter part strong breeze and fair weather from SE put up waist boat and painter her making spinnaker

Remarks on board Sunday 12th

this day strong breeze and fair weather all day both saw nothing latter part strong breeze from SE of M took 4 1/2 gals oil Lat 9-24
Long 31-10

Remarks on board Monday 13th

this day strong breeze from SE and fine weather all day both saw nothing & SE latter part light wind and fine weather from SE put new blank strap to Gas boat and starboard boat & copper setting up new shooks & one sail in side board & Lat 11-30
Long 31-01

Remarks on board Tuesday 14th

this day light wind and fine weather from SE latter part the quarter block to M of sail yard new stumpy copper set latter part light wind and fine weather but men block straps to waist and board boat and rose new falls copper & tag in cash Lat 11-50
Long 30-45

Remarks on board Wednesday 15th

this day light wind and fine weather from Eastward came NE hitting the rigging & latter part light wind and fine weather

all hand in play in starting fresh water out of the rigging and putting aboard and blank track & Lat 14-25
Long 29-59

Remarks on board Thursday 16th

this day light wind and fine weather from N from East started fresh water and fitting with salt latter part strong breeze and cloudy took in board boat and putting a new stumpy standing water and splicing with salt Lat 15-40
Long 29-25
