this day light wind from NE and
fine weather from NE all sail set
number sail in site saw grasshoppers
mountain ship in side of mountain over
the bear place & latter part light
light wind and some sand from NE
all sail set saw an steamer steering
saw netst filling up ship for part
Galt 28-41
Galt 48 44

April 1 1866 Remarks on board Sunday 1

this day light and fair weather from
NE all sail set saw nothing at 8 am
saw the land distance 30 miles bar per
compass NW at 10 am huff to the
wind began a back latter part light
and cloudy NE at 5 1/2 am bore force
head in for the land at 9 am huff of
SW breaking in for the harbor and
rain squall

Remarks on board Monday 2
this day strong breeze from NE tow
and plenty of rain at 1 pm came to
anchor in 4 1/2 fathoms of water bark
spray of new Buffalo Capt Curllan
400 lb 20 90 wt at 5 pm first 2 1/2
saw at 6 ship after 9th came to

anchor at 9 pm sail with plenty of
rain latter part strong breeze from
rain squall

Remarks on board Tuesday 3
this day light wind and fair weather setting
up shocks & latter part light from
NE clearing the breeze got off raft of
water the captain up to the city to enter
the ship Galt the sail to off to
custon house officer came on board and
saw the helms next morning took
off

At anchor At St Catharina Brazil

Remarks on board Wednesday 4
this day light wind and fair from NE
standing down water setting back shocks
latter part light wind fine calm got
raft of water came return from entering
his ship

Remarks on board Thursday 5
this day standing down water in for head
at 8 am strong breeze from south
and plenty of rain thunder and lightning
latter part strong breeze at 6 pm left
from south standing down go starker anchor
balt water

Remarks on board Friday 6
this day strong breeze from south standing
down water & latter part strong breeze
and rainy weather from south

Remarks on board Saturday 7
this day light wind from NE and sand to the
harbor anchor and got a pot from the
shear to smoke ship & latter strong breeze
and cloudy from south sent a raft on line
to raised boat the sail

Remarks on board Sunday 8
this day strong breeze and sand from NE
latter part light and calm the men on
board

Remarks on board Monday 9
this day light wind and rain squall
John Henry Charles Hilder Charles Manja
the Miller Michel Allen John Rogers
Jim Dyer Norman Robert Coates
latter part light and rain squall got off raft
of water Robert and Jim came on board at
8 am

Remarks on board Tuesday 10
this day light wind from NE standing down
water sent 5 casks on shear for water
latter part light and calm about the
sail to an commen smoking ship at 9 1/2 am
shot her up got 5 cask water 7 men
liberty
