this day fine weather and strong breeze from the North latter part fair weather cant 2 of the crew, John Sheels and Charles Eubels the rest we could not get. their names, John Henry, Otto Millard, John Bogert, Charles Mengar, Michael Allen something Davis,

Remarks on board Wednesday 2nd

this day light wind and cloudy ship ready for sea latter part light wind and variable at 4 AM caught all hands and bore short at 4 took made sail and took our anchor and standing out the Bay ship 7 men Antonio Macky George Lewis John Robinson J. V. Holden, Ellis, Davis, John Mott Robert Dickerson in company with Boatswain Capt Cornell

Remarks on board Thursday 3rd

this day strong breeze from South at 12 noon took in 2 of sail & getting anchor on the bow at 2 double reef 2 sail made at sail at 4 PM finish with the anchor and chains and worked the deck & took up the boats & took John Sheels and Charles Eubels out of ions and sent them to their duty Davis is a getting a long first rate, and, Ben Ship is still in ions latter part strong breeze from South made all sail getting the Boat ready took Ben out of ions set him to work

this day strong breeze from NW sail set at 5 PM put Ben in ion & gin latter part strong breeze from NW all sail set latter the anchor was took Ben out of ion

this day light air and calm & Breeze put Ben in ions leaving soft aft fell from Mizzen top saw deck their was a loss time we lost the deck aiding deck with brook his fall he was badly hurt but no bones broken latter part strong breeze and fair weather at 1 PM saw Spennish whale at 10 PM

this day strong breeze and fair weather at 12 noon struck and hild at 12 took the along side we commence cutting at 8 PM got the head off ship cutting 1st & 2nd or the third mate is sick with a lame back he has bin sick more or less with the fever since we left home. latter part strong breeze and fair weather from NW at 5 PM commenced cutting, & got in by 9
