latter part strong breezes from
the south at 2 PM got under way
and standing out to sea to the eastward
in company with the Calliope
latter part light wind and fine weather
from south course NE

Remark on board 21st

this day strong breezes and squalls
of rain at 2 PM spoke Bark Callao
at 4 PM saw far hump back got
nothing course NE
latter part strong breezes and squalls
from NE course NE

NE and Calles NE NE spoke Bark

from south at 6 PM calm latter part
calm at 10 AM light wind from NE
