Latter Part light wind and fair
weather from Eastward standing
down the Main Land in
sight distance 10 miles

this day strong breeze and fair
weather from N E saw number
whale at night shortened sail 2
Latter Part fresh gail from North
and rain by night at 3 am took 4 1/2 sail
about 100 N E sail at 9 calm or light
air from N E at 10 wind N E with
strong breeze

Aug 1 1866, this day strong breeze from
N E and fair weather plenty
of lightning over the land and to
the sea board got nothing Latter
Part strong breeze from 1 pm to 5

N sail
