 Remark on board Sunday 12th
 this day strong breeze from SW
 and rain. Minced blubber of
 the rite whale calf and cutting the
 blubber of hump back &
 Latter Part light wind and rain squalls
 from SW boat went out got
 nothing

Remark on board Mon 13th
 this day strong breeze from
 South to SE Latter Part
 light wind from SE fair weather
 boats out commence bailing out
 back Callao of New Bedford cut
 Brown left to day for St
 Catharines

Remark on board 14th
 this day strong breeze from
 East and finish bailing &
 Latter Part strong breeze and fair
 heavy sea running out & in
 stowing down oil

Remark on board Wed 15th
 this day strong breeze from
 East and side starting down
 Latter Part strong breeze and fair
 from NE and raised ship drag her
 Anchor let go Starboard Anchor &

Remark on board Thursday 16th
 this day strong breeze fair weather from
 NE at 8 AM wind light at 5 light air off
 the land scrape the board & at 9 AM
 paid out more chain at 10 AM wind shifted
 to SE & burst of lightning Latter Part
 strong breeze from SE and cloudy
 take up Starboard Anchor &

At Anchor St Anna Bay Brazil
 Remark on board Friday 17th
 this day strong breeze from SW
 and thick cloudy weather Latter Part
 strong breeze from South & boats out
 getting fresh water

Remark on board Sat 18th
 this day strong breeze from East and
 gifting and spook & fair weather
 Latter Part strong breeze from SE
 & boat out filling cask of salt water

Remark on board Sun 19th
 this day light wind from East and
 got nothing washing ship &
 Latter Part light wind from NW
 calm & canoe came off from
 the shore with 2 hundred orange

Remark on board Mon 20th
 this day light wind from East and
 ship ready for sea & Latter Part
 light air and calm from NE & both
 at 4 AM got under way and started
 sea hauled up all the chains from
 below and cleared them

Remark on board Tues 21st
 this day light wind from SE to East
 take the anchors on the board and
 bent the chains and put them below
 put the starboard chain on the
 Starboard side & shifted them
 the land in sight & Latter Part
 strong breeze and cloudy from North
 at 10 AM double reef take in gill
 and Main sail
