Remarks on board Monday 17

this day rain at 4 pm breeze from North sent in a boat fetch the rest of the wack and the cook has bin a shower of day on a drunk Latter Part light and plenty of rain wack on liberty

Remarks on board Tues 18th

this day light air and calm and rain Latter Part rain wack return the black smith on the way and Charles Eublin bought 40 of Molasses

Remarks on board Wed 19

this day light air and calm from N.E. and Trades Latter Part fine rain and foggy wind variable at 11 am capt went to town

Remarks on board Thurs 20

this day light air and calm and clear Latter Part rains Black Smith and Charles Eublin saw nothing of them

Remarks on board Friday 21st

this day variable wind and rain at 4 am capt returned Latter Part strong breezes fair weather off repairs to sail bought 4 barrels of black beans, 1 bag of

Garemae Remarks on board Saturday 22

this day strong breezes and fair from S.W. finish repair of sail and bent it at 4 pm ship Nigger of New Bedford capt clearing 120 to Latter Part light air clear from South east the sail to 3

Remarks on board Sund 23

this day light wind from S.W. fair the sail Latter Part strong breezes from the North all hand on board ship ready for sea, and sold 17 bbls 4 gallons of whale and hump back oil at 5-14 gallon 30 gallon per barrel at 62 1/2 cents per gallon

At Anchor St Catharine Brazil

Remarks on board Monday 24

this day strong breezes and fair weather from North all hand on board Latter Part strong breezes from North wind a head heard nothing from Black Smith or Eublin they have steamed

Remarks on board Tues 25th

this day strong breezes from North ship ready for sea all hand on board Latter Part light air from N.W. at 5 am got under way standing out at 10 am came to anchor tide sitting ship 3 min Antonio

Remarks on board Wednesday 26

this day light from N.W. at 4 am tide turned sitting out got under way wind light at 6 calm at 7 light wind from N.W. standing out the bay Latter Part light wind from East and thick and raining the land in sight took the anchors on the bow undent the chains etc

Remarks on board Thurs 27th

this day light wind thick raining from N.W. all sail down at 6 am Latter Part calm and foggy at 11 am light from South bearing Easter
