 this day light wind from South
 at 2 Pm boat came on board
 got nothing latter part strong
 breezes and cloudy from South
 saw hump back going NW
 Lat 29.25
 Long 48.25

Remark on board Sun 30
 this day strong breezes and cloudy from
 South at 3 Pm in light sail
 at 5 double reef of sail saw hump
 back going NW latter part
 light wind and fair weather at 11
 board for hump back got nothing
 Lat 30.10
 Long 48.35

Remark on board Mon 1st
 this day light air and fine weather
 from NE to S all sail set and
 ship in sight heading to South latter
 part strong breezes and cloudy from
 NE all sail set 3 sail in sight
 and one steamer
 Lat 31.00
 Long 49.05

bound to River Laplate
 Remark on board Tuesday 2

this day strong breezes and cloudy from
 NE some light squalls
 and rain double reef of sail and took in
 all sail latter part light sail and rain
 Lat 32.15
 Long 49.15

Remark on board Wed 3rd
 this day strong breeze from NE and light
 rain squalls latter part light
 wind and foggy squall all sail set
 Lat 34.46
 Long 51.25

Remark on board Thursday 4th
 this day strong breezes from NE and
 cloudy with light squalls
 yards and making spars again the
 latter part strong breeze and thick
 weather at 9 am heard off good
 weather
 Lat 34.55
 Long 51.40

Remark on board Friday 5th
 this day strong breezes and fair
 weather from South at 6 Pm shorter
 sail latter part light wind and cloudy
 made all sail
 Lat 35.00
 Long 52.00

Remark on board Saturday 6th
 this day light wind and foggy squall
 from South can't see far
 at 6 shorten sail latter part
 strong breezes made all sail at 6
 am saw sperm whale going ENE
 quick found it came in thick
 fog saw nothing more of them
