Remark on board Frida 12th
this day strong breezes and fair
weather from South at 4 Pm
saw one white whale going Southward
and western board got nothing one
white whale, bar to the legend a whaling
latter part strong breezes

the whale taking up the stowing
white whale, boat the day broke at 11 Pm
