this day strong breezes and fair and cloudy from NW put out the west boat shorten sail latter part light air and fine weather all sail set and nothing latter 35-45-

this day strong breezes and cloudy from NW at 6 Whistled sail soust reef M. & sail and 1/2 sail with fresh gale latter part strong breezes at 6 am made sail at 6 m. all sail at 8 took in light sail at 9 double reef 1/2 sail finish west boat later & latter 36-00

this day strong breezes and cloudy from the south double reef 1/2 sail at 6 shorten no sail bound south filling the hour to the forehand boat & latter part strong breezes from and cloudy made sail
