this day light wind from North all sail set the land in site to the distance by Ob 44 miles sound 5 h fathoms set 4 tops in light sail at 10 strong breeze from West and soust reef M^d sail below board in squalls or gust latter part strong breeze at 11 noon and same cloud from N^W to N^E at 3.00 set double reef of sail

this day strong breeze and squalls from N^W to N^E double reef M^d sail at 5.15 and 1/2 sail the land in site latter part soust reef M^d sail and stay sail from 6 am to 8 am strong gale and rain squalls moderate made some sail wind from N^W to N^E
