Sat 23 Remark: on board
this day strong breezes from NE
stowing down oil at 4 PM took the
remainders of the Callao oil on deck.
Latter Part light wind from NW
and fair weather stowing down callao
oil in after hold

Sund 24 Remark: on board
this day light wind and fair weather
stowing oil in Fore hold Latter Part
calm and rain squalls wash on
Liberty

Mon 25 Remark: on board
this day rain squalls from
South Latter Part light wind from
NW finish stowing down the oil
got up two boat loads of wood
hoist the sail to try wash return

Tues Day 26 Remark: on board
this day light from NW got raft
of water fired the sail at 6 PM
from fresh gail from South
Latter Part light wind from NW
Savitarin ship got up raft of
water as it went to the city

Wed 27 Remark: on board
this day light wind and fair weather
stowing down water at 4 PM
fresh gail from South at 6
light wind from SW Latter
Part light wind from NW
got off raft of water

Thurs 28 Remark: on board
this day strong breezes from North
stowing down of water &c
Latter Part light wind from NW
Savitarin ship wash on belly
