sailed 4th barrel of Beef 9th at 9

box 4 sack of Potatoes 5th

8 Remark on board
this day strong breeze from north
getting ready for sea Latter sent
strong breeze sent getting ready for sea

this day strong breeze from NE and
cloudy Latter sent light wind from
SE getting ready for sea 4

Sun 10 Remark on board

this day light wind from north ship
all day for sea Latter sent
light from south at 6 Pm take
our anchor and bound out of the
Bay George and Ben run a way
Manuel and Antonio discharge
they ship for sea soon and ship and
man

Monday 11 Remark on board
this day light wind from south
at 4 Pm strong breeze north
stood the anchor & chains at 6
the Land in distance 12 miles
Latter sent strong breeze
from NE all sail set

Thurs 12 Remark on board

this day strong breeze from NE
to East and rain at 4 Pm took
in 4th sail Latter sent strong
breeze and cloudy from south all
sail set saw nothing 8 sail in
to day

Wed 13 Remark on board
this day light wind from SE
at 6 Pm in light Latter sent calm
at 6th Am saw sperm at 4th board at 11
struck the whale landed and took the line
Whale light air from East and Bark sparten in
sile

Thurs 14 Remark on board
this day light wind from East and whales
going to the West and 2 Pm sparten boat
started in company with sparten at 4
Pm took the whale a long of the sparten
Mary Frazier being 15 miles to the wind
commenced cutting at 8 capt return left
our boat crew on board to help cut
Latter sent strong breeze and night
cutting in the whale 2 boat on board
sparten

this day strong breeze from north and
rain at 1 Pm got head off 5th cut in
the day at 4 got in junk at 9 got
the case in end at 10 a boat crew
returned to the Mary Latter sent light
wind and fine weather made all sail 10
Latt in

7 Ascend on board 1 large box 1 chest of medicines
9 bundles of all Damages boxes and 2 bundles was
to bundle over all from 8 January 26th 1867
have cut of Bone and Wharf 12 with white cement
