 miles of them and stayed by our course
 saw a ship latter part of the day
 Lat 20.11 Long 27.26



Tuesday Nov 12th begins with
 fair weather pleasant breeze from
 N & E Steered S & E saw two sails the
 watch employed at incidental duty
 Lat 18.38 Long 28.18

Wednesday Nov 13th begins with
 fair weather and good breeze from N & E
 Steered S & E made all sail saw
 jammers and one sail watch employed
 variously Lat 16.57 Long 28.58

Thursday Nov 14th begins with
 cloudy weather good breeze from about
 East Steered S & E with fair weather
 S & E latter part watch employed variously
 Lat 15.26 Long 29.37

Friday Nov 15th begins with
 cloudy weather good breeze from South
 Steered by the wind on the Port tack
 till 1 P.M. and tacked ship went from
 S.W. some of the time and from
 S.E. some of the time latter part
 saw 2 sails and jammers Lat 14.32 Long 26.22

Saturday Nov 16th begins with
 pleasant breeze from South Steered
 by the wind on the Starboard
 tack till 7 P.M. and tacked ship light
 air latter part saw two or three
 sails Lat 14.03 Long 26.40

Sunday Nov 17th begins with
 calm and light air from the
 Southward Steered by the wind rain
 squalls latter part watch employed
 variously Lat 14.06 Long 26.38

Monday Nov 18th begins with
 calm squalls and light air from
 all around the compass the
 course S & E by South watch employed
 setting up topmast rigging and
 head stay Lat 13.45 Long 26.29

Tuesday Nov 19th begins with
 squalls and light air from
 about North Steered S & E by South
 saw jammers and three sails watch
 employed at incidental duty
 Lat 13.33 Long 26.11
