Bark Mary Flag of New Bedford Capt. Caldwell
Wednesday Nov 20th Began with
light breeze from E & E Steered
S & by South had it equally some
of the time saw two sails so ends
no heat no long

Thursday Nov 21st Began with
gentle breeze from about East
Steered by the wind on the Port
tack saw Blackfish at noon
lowered 4 Boat Whist and Row Boat
caught one each good breeze latter part
the day so ends Lat 41 38 Long 24 42

Friday Nov 22nd Began
with cloudy weather but good
breeze from E & E Steered by the
wind on the Port tack saw 4 or 5
sails watch employed trying out
the two Blackfish so ends the day
Lat 40 58 Long 24 38

Saturday Nov 23rd Began
with cloudy weather gentle
breeze from E & E Steered by the
wind on the Starboard tack
saw one sail through the saw mine
for then sail showed Lat 40 22 Long 24 24

Sunday Nov 24th Began with
fine weather light breeze from
East Steered by the wind on the
Port tack better breeze latter
part the day saw four or five
sails so ends Lat 41 22 Long 23 19
saw Blackfish lowered the Boat
but got nothing

Bound to the River Plate
Monday Nov 25th Began with
fine weather good breeze from
about E & E Steered by the wind
on the Port tack saw nothing
but sails so ends Lat 41 25 Long 22 22

Tuesday Nov 26th Began with
fine weather good breeze from
East Steered by East saw sails
all ground watch employed variously
so ends the day Lat 41 33 Long 21 58

Wednesday 27th Began with
calm and light air from
the Eastward Steered South
saw Blackfish at 8 AM lowered
four Boats Whist Boat got one covered
for more at 11 30 AM so ends
Lat 41 22 Long 21 35

Thursday Nov 28th Began with
fair weather light breeze from
N & E Steered by East lowered
for Blackfish at 4 PM got none
rained all night and a heavy
squall at 4 PM burst the
Main topsail cald all hands
and furled everything rained
til 10 AM so ends Lat none Long none

Friday Nov 29th Began with
a calm and light air from
S & E Steered by the wind on the
Port tack rained all night and
all the latter part the day so ends
no observation
