Friday Dec 21st begins with
fine weather good breeze from
North Steered S. E. with all
sail out row one sail the watch
employed at incidental duty so ends
Lat 23.12 Long

Saturday Dec 22nd begins with
rainy weather good breeze from
North till 3 Pm got the wind
from South Steered by the wind
on the Starboard tack saw two
sails and a school of porpoises
so ends the day Lat 23.54 Long 23.50

Sunday Dec 23rd begins with
fair weather fresh breeze from
S. E. Steered by the wind till
4 Pm and tacked ship and the
wind was from E. S. E. later part
saw nothing worthy of remark
so ends the day Lat 24.14 Long

Monday Dec 24th begins with
fair weather and fresh breeze
from E. S. E. Steered South by
West Strong breeze and rainy weather
later part saw large white water at 8
9.20 A.M. supposed to be sperm whales
so ends the day no observation

Tuesday Dec 25th begins with
rainy stormy weather fresh breeze from
N. E. till 4 Pm and then from N. W.
Steered S. E. got the wind from South
at day light had a moderate gale
till noon laid hove to on the Port
tack so ends the day Lat 23.44 Long

Bound to the Indian Ocean
Wednesday Dec 26th begins with
strong breeze from South sailed by the
wind on the Port tack till 4 Pm and
wore ship wind from S. E. later part
the day saw one sail so ends the day
Lat 29.54 Long 24.14

Thursday Dec 27th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
S. E. Steered by the wind on the
Port tack saw nothing but a few porpoises
the watch employed at intervals
so ends the day Lat 31.31 Long 24.55

Friday Dec 28th begins with
fine weather pleasant breeze from
E. S. E. Steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack saw nothing worthy
of remark the last 24 hours
the watch employed breaking out
the main hatch to Cooper some
bread and flour so ends the day
Lat 32.28 Long 24.43

Saturday Dec 29th begins with
calm and light breeze from E. S. E.
Steered S. E. some of the time
had all sail clewed up most
all night light breeze later part
from N. W. Steered S. E. so ends
Lat 32.40 Long 24.00

Sunday Dec 30th begins
with light breeze from N. W.
Steered S. E. by light breeze later
part the day Steered S. E. by head
saw three or four porpoises and
one sail so ends the day
Lat 33.25 Long 22.21
