Monday Dec 3rd began with
fine weather good breeze from
N.W. Steered S.E. by East with all
sail out strong breeze latter part the
day saw one sail so ends the day
Lat 34 22 Long 19 57

Tuesday Jan 1st began with
strong breeze from N.W. & N
steered S.E. by E. calm and light air
latter part accompanied with rain
saw two sails and four or five
sunkets so ends Lat 34 55 Long 15 57

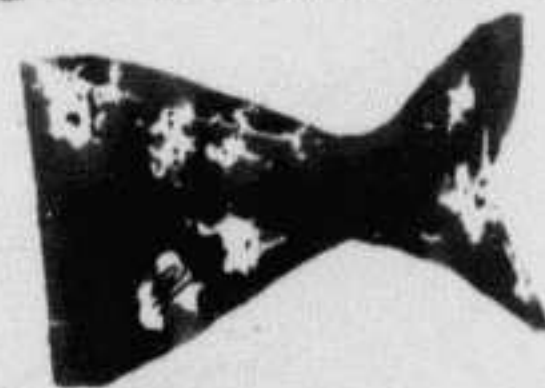
Wednesday Jan 2nd began with
cloudy weather light breeze from West
steered S.E. strong breeze all the
latter part the day saw nothing
but one sail and four or five
sunkets so ends Lat 36 16 Long 13 19

Thursday Jan 3rd began with
strong breeze from about West steered
S.E. at dark and shortened sail and
dipped to the wind saw the Island of
Indian D. Curica and Inexpressible
about 20 miles off light breeze latter
part so ends the day Lat 36 38 Long 12 02

Friday Jan 4th began with
fine weather good breeze from N.W.
steered S.E. South passed by the land
18 miles off did not go ashore after Potatoes
because they did not keep any to give away
fine weather all the latter part
saw two sails so ends Lat 36 27 Long 07 02

Bound to the Indian Ocean 1868
Saturday Jan 5th began with
fair weather good breeze from North
steered S.E. by East fore part and E.S.E.
the latter part had a moderate Gale
from dark till daylight laid hove to
from 1 Am till 4 Am so ends Lat 36 48 Long 05 08

Sunday Jan 6th began with
half a gail from N.W. steered S.E. by E
with Main top Gallant sail out saw
a large school of Sperm Whales at 3 P.M.
heaving N.E. very slow but did not see
them till the ship ran into them
I dipped to a little while and continued
our course moderate Gale all the
latter part so ends Lat 36 22 Long 02 13



Monday Jan 7th began with a moderate
Gale from West steered S.E. by E moderate
weather latter part saw a Whaling
Bark hove to at 6 P.M. so ends the day
Lat 36 27 Long 00 20 East

Tuesday Jan 8th began with
fine weather good breeze from
North steered S.E. by E the watch
employed repairing fore and Main top
Gallant sail saw nothing so ends
Lat 36 57 Long 04 15

Wednesday Jan 9th began with
fair weather but strong breeze from
North steered S.E. by East
thick weather till latter part
saw nothing worthy of remark the
last 24 hours so ends the day Lat 37 33 Long 07 52
