

Bark Mary Francis of New Bedford Capt Caldwell 1868
Thursday Jan 10th began with
thick fog and good breeze from N.E. & W.
steered S.E. by East shortened sail at
dark and luffed to the wind steered
N.E. till part saw nothing so ends the day
Lat 37 37 Long 9 25

Friday Jan 11th began with
foggy weather thick fog between the time
good breeze from N.E. & W. steered S.E. by
East saw a hump back cow and calf
at 7 P.M. shortened sail at dark and
steered South saw one sail wind from
South latter part the day so ends
navigation

Saturday Jan 12th began with
rainy foggy weather strong breeze from
South steered by the wind on the
starboard tack better weather latter part
had the wind from S.E. saw one sail
so ends the day Lat 37 03 Long 13 05.

Sunday Jan 13th began with
fine weather pleasant breeze from S.E.
steered by the wind on the starboard tack
at the wind from West at midnight
and steered S.E. saw nothing
so ends the day Lat 36 23 Long 18 24

Monday Jan 14th began with
fine weather good breeze from West
steered S.E. with all sail put
fresh breeze latter part the day saw
nothing worthy of remark the Lat
24 hours so ends the day Lat 36 37 Long 16 00

Bound to the Indian Ocean 1868
Tuesday Jan 15th began with
fresh breeze from N.E. & W. steered S.E.
with all sail out wind from East the
latter part the day steered by the wind
on the port tack saw nothing
so ends Lat 36 38 Long 18 05

Wednesday Jan 16th began with
fine weather pleasant breeze
from East steered by the wind on
the port tack got a good breeze at daylight
from S.W. and steered S.E. the water
employed roasting the bread and flour
from the gale hold and coopering
the same so ends Lat 37 18 Long 19 55

Thursday Jan 17th began with
fine weather till 3 P.M. got a strong
breeze from S.E. & W. with some rain
steered S.E. by East saw four or
five hump backs so ends the day
Lat 37 10 Long 22 48

Friday Jan 18th began with
fair weather good breeze from S.W.
steered S.E. by East with all sail
set wind from S.E. & E latter part
the day steered by the wind on the
starboard tack so ends the day
Lat 37 10 Long 23 49

Saturday Jan 19th began with
fine weather light breeze from
S.E. & E steered by the wind on the
starboard tack saw numerous
nothing worthy of remark the
24 hours so ends Lat 36 30 Long 24 14
