the after topbail latter part saw two sails
so ends Lat 35 27 Long 26 42

Tuesday Jan 22nd begins with
fine weather good breeze from NW
steered SE the watch employed
latter part repairing the fly jib saw
nothing so ends Lat 35 35 Long 28 40

Wednesday Jan 23rd begins with
light breeze from NW steered SE
by East calm most all night got
a breeze at daylight from NE steered
by the wind on the Port tack saw
nothing so ends Lat 36 26 Long 30 06

Thursday Jan 24th begins with
bony weather light breeze from NE
steered by the wind on the Port tack
saw a school of Grampuses of the wind
sign SEW at 8 Pm steered East
strong breeze latter part so ends
Lat 35 15 Long 32 40

Bound to the Coast of Madagascar
Friday Jan 25th begins with strong breeze
from SEW steered East till the wind
from ESE at day light steered by the
wind on the Starboard tack under
single reefed topsail so ends the day
Lat 33 40 Long 39 42

Saturday Jan 26th begins with
strong breeze from ESE steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack spoke
a Brig bound to Cape Town at 1 Pm tasked
Ship at 11 Pm saw another sail at
7 Pm bound to the Westward so ends
Lat 33 50 Long 35 34

Sunday Jan 27th begins with
strong breeze from about E by N
steered by the wind on the Port tack
with single reefed top sails fine
weather latter part breeze from the
same place so ends Lat 34 36 Long 36 59

Monday Jan 28th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
East steered by the wind on the
Port tack at 7 Pm and wore Ship
strong breeze latter part the day
saw nothing so ends the day
Lat 34 04 Long 36 58

Tuesday Jan 29th begins with
strong breeze from East steered
by the wind on the Port tack
saw blackfish 9 Am covered three
Boats the Starboard Boat caught one
so ends the day Lat 34 55 Long 38 17
