

Saturday Feb 29th begins with light breeze
from about East N. E. struck another
large whale at 1.30 Pm turned him up right away
but did not get him going like the first
set the watch at 8 Pm with both whales
along side begin to cut at 6 Am finished
cutting one whale at 11 Pm head off
at 11 Am. So ends Lat 14 26 Long 51 20

Sunday March 1st begins with
breeze weather fine
cutting one whale at 5 Pm and
started the work begin to cut at 6 Am
got his head off at 7.30 Am. So ends
Lat 14 05 Long 50 52

Monday March 2nd begins with
fine weather finished cutting at Pm
all hands employed latter part
boiling cutting up junk &c. So ends
Lat none Long 50

Tuesday March 3rd begins
with fine weather light breeze from
the Westward all hands employed
fore part the day boiling &c. the only
latter part So ends Lat 11 42 Long 51 52

Wednesday March 4th begins
with fine weather the watch employed
boiling &c finished boiling at 6 Pm and
put on the fat train saw one loop
and told by Lumpyback second and
fourth whale two that showed three
men forward and the Cooper all sick
the third almost as bad. So ends
Lat 10 58 Long 50 26

Thursday March 5th begins with
fine weather fore part the day rainy
weather latter part light breeze from
West the watch employed variously
So ends Lat 10 Long 48 56

Friday March 6th begins with
fine weather pleasant breeze from about
N. W. steered by the wind on the Port
tack the watch employed variously saw
nothing but humpbacks So ends Lat 11 00 Long 51 26

Saturday March 7th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
N. W. steered N. E. all hands employed
storing off the main forepart the watch
employed latter repairing the fly jib
So ends Lat 10 20 Long 52 16

Sunday March 8th begins with
fine weather pleasant breeze from
N. W. steered by the wind on the Port
tack wind from N. W. & W. latter part
saw nothing So ends Lat 8 14 Long 52 37

Monday March 9th begins with
fine weather good breeze from N. W.
steered by the wind on the Port
tack till 1 Pm and then the ship
backed again at 1 Pm saw nothing
So ends Lat 8 58 Long 52 40
