Bark Mary, Trader of New Bedford
Friday, March 10th Began with
fine weather good breeze from West
Steered N by West for part the day
Steered N by East latter part the day
Saw nothing so ended Lat 5.00 Long 53.06

Wednesday, March 11th Began with
fine weather good breeze from about C. N. W.
Steered N. E. till 4 Pm and luffed to
the wind then the Chain and anchors
at 4 Pm laid aback all night at 5.00 am
kept off and Steered East at 10.00 am
run on to a Shoal of 10 fathoms off
water kept off a while and Steered
East by South again so ended Lat 4.45 Long 54.25

Thursday, March 12th Began with
fine weather good breeze from N. W.
Steered East by North saw the Island
of Shiquette at 4 Pm about 35 miles off
got the anchor off the Bow at 4 Pm
took in the Light Sails at 7 Pm and luffed
to the wind till late night began to Steer
S. E. at daylight passed Shiquette at 8 am took
a Pilot at 11 am Anchored in Market Harbor at
noon so ended the day

Friday, March 13th Began with
fine weather got the mail packet at 9 am and
got a gag of Quakers ready to land ashore in the
morning got the raft ashore at 7 am and got
it filled at noon got it aboard at 4 Pm
painted the Starboard side of the Ship
Let the Starboard Watch have a run ashore
tonight landed the fourth Mate two Boat Steers
Boiler and two men forward to day all sick with Scurvy
this day contained 36 Scurvy so ended the day

Saturday, March 14th Began with
fine weather no breeze at all got a raft
of Water lowered it away painted the Starboard
side and cleared up decks so ended

Sunday, March 15th Began with fine
weather light breeze from North
fore part calm most of the time
sent the Starboard watch ashore on
Liberty at 7 am so ended the day

Monday, March 16th Began with
fine weather the Watch returned
from in good order sent Starboard Watch
ashore on Liberty painted the fore Mast
and got a small raft of Water so ended

Tuesday, March 17th Began with
cloudy and rainy weather the watch all
returned from shore except one John Crampton
sent the Starboard Watch ashore on
Liberty so ended so the John Dawson
arrived at 4 Pm so ended

Wednesday, March 18th Began with
rainy weather most of the day the watch
returned from shore except one in good order
sent the Starboard Watch ashore on
Liberty the watch on board employed
variously so ended this day
