fine weather Antonio & Mammal Giza &c
Mammal &c left last night
the Watch left went ashore on Liberty
So ends the day

Monday March 23rd Began with
fine weather all hands on board
hauling for Pies fruit &c got all ready
for use in the morning
So ends the day

Cruising on the Mahe Banks for Spinn 1868
Tuesday March 24th Began with
a calm the Pilot came on board at 6 am
more short and at 7 am they at 7 am
towed out of the Harbor with four
Boats got a light breeze at 8 am from
East passed the Island of Salomon at noon
this day contained only 12 hours So ends
P.S. Ship a native of Mahe named Anthony

Wednesday March 25th Began with
fine weather pleasant breeze from
East Steered by West Salomon 20 miles
off at 10 am sighted Port Salomon at
11 am saw a ship at anchor and some
Grampuses So ends Lat 5.42 Long 55.23

Thursday March 26th Began with
fine weather light breeze
from East Steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack till 4 pm and tacked
back wind from South latter part saw
them at 8.30 am covered 8 that at
9 am at 10 am got among them and
gained them So ends Lat Long

Friday March 27th Began with
fine weather light wind from South
lowered the Starboard Boat covered
at 1 pm all 4 boats chased till 6 pm but saw
nothing and give them up Made in sight
all day heading N by East and by the
wind all day at Steered by the wind
latter part on the Port tack So ends
Lat 5.30 Long 55.15
