

Bark *Mar. Frasier* of *Ch. Bedford* Capt. Caldwell
Monday Apr 6th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from the Eastward
Stood four or five courses Land 20 miles
off calm all the latter part the day So ends
Lat 4.54 Long 56.59

Tuesday Apr 7th Begins with
a calm but sultry weather the fourth
mate two blackbirds one man forward
has been sick the last four days
the 3rd taken down sick today most all
the Make I stand in light all day light
breeze from West latter part So ends Lat 4.14 Long 58.14

Wednesday Apr 8th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from West
steered by the wind in the Port tack
saw at daylight saw the *Herald* and
saw *Dawson* I engaged them both all day
I saw Blackfish at ends Lat none Long

Thursday Apr 9th Begins with
fine weather light air from S.E.
steered S.E. beginning at 11 Am
first Lapoint very sick no wind at
all latter part So ends Lat 5.57 Long 58.46

Friday Apr 10th Begins with
a calm saw the *Dawson* and *Herald*
all day good breeze latter part from N.W.
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack of the Cook is off duty sick
So ends Lat 4.30 Long 57.10

Bound to *Agua de Malha* Bunk to *Carid* 1868
Saturday Apr 11th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from N.W.
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack saw the *Herald* and *Dawson* Capt
off S.E. at 11 am So ends Lat 5.38 Long 58.07

Sunday Apr 12th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from West steered
S.E. wind from S.W. latter part saw
nothing worthy of remark the last 2.4 courses
So ends the day Lat 5.38 Long 58.06

Monday Apr 13th Begins with
fine weather light air from S.W.
steered S.E. good breeze from N.W.
the latter part saw nothing but Porpoises
the watch employed variously So ends
Lat 6.55 Long 58.48

Tuesday Apr 14th Begins with
fair weather good breeze from about
N.W. steered S.E. by South light
breeze latter part saw nothing but
Porpoises the fourth mate returned
to duty after being sick several days
So ends Lat 7.54 Long 59.44

Wednesday Apr 15th Begins with
fine weather light air from N.W.
steered S.E. shortened sail and cuped
to the wind at dark saw Blackfish at
7 am the watch employed variously
So ends Lat 8.02 Long 59.57
