Wednesday May 6th begins with
half a Gale from N N E by North
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack had a moderate Gale latter part
from North to end Lat 15 29 Long 61 03

Thursday May 7th begins with
a moderate Gale from North to on
the Starboard tack till 5 Pm and wore
Ship the weather continued about the
same all day saw nothing so end Lat 16 00 Long 61 03

Friday May 8th begins with
a moderate Gale from North to
on the Port tack under close reefed Main
top sail fore part good weather latter part
the watch employed drying sails &c
so end Lat 16 22 Long 62 24

Saturday May 9th begins with
fine weather but a heavy sea running
good breeze from N N E steered by the
wind on the Starboard tack arrived
from S E N E latter part watch employed
repairing the main top sail to end Lat 15 28 Long 61 47

Sunday May 10th begins with
fine weather good breeze from E N E
steered by the wind on the Starboard tack
wind from East latter part steered
N by East saw four Finbacks
so end Lat 13 52 Long 61 48

Monday May 11th begins with
fine weather good breeze from East
steered N by East latter part through
the night light breeze latter part from
South so end Lat 12 46 Long 61 16

Tuesday May 12th begins with
fine weather good breeze from S E
steered N N E sent down the fore top sail
sent the main top sail in the forenoon it
at 4 Pm repaired the flying jib latter part
so end Lat 10 40 Long 61 01

Wednesday May 13th begins with
fair weather good breeze from S E
steered N N E repaired the fore top sail
fore part rainy and squally latter part
saw nothing so end Lat 9 03 Long none

Thursday May 14th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
S E steered N E by North watch
employed repairing the fore top sail fore
part repairing the main sail latter
part so end Lat 7 46 Long 62 37

Friday May 15th begins with
light land wind rain squall from
about S E steered N E by North
watch employed repairing the main
sail saw nothing so end
Lat 7 16 Long 62 42
