Friday June 5th the wind with
fresh breeze from South Steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack till
dark and were ship down at daylight
to Cooper and saw Brown the Wil
with all hands so ends Lat 3 16 Long 56 14

Saturday June 6th the wind with
fresh breeze from West Steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack finished
storing the oil at 8 pm Steered 61 S 11 E
till ship at 9 pm so ends Lat 3 30 Long 55 55

Sunday June 7th the wind with
fresh breeze from S W Steered by the
wind on the Port tack the watch employed
variously Strong breeze the whole 24 hours
saw nothing so ends Lat 3 20 Long 53 35

Monday June 8th the wind with
Strong breeze from S W Steered by the
wind on the Port tack till dark and
tacked ship the watch employed variously
saw nothing so ends Lat 3 30 Long 56 38

Tuesday June 9th the wind with
Strong breeze from S W Steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack
fine weather latter part carried all
saw the watch employed at a little
of everything so ends Lat 4 04 Long 57 53

Wednesday June 10th the wind with
fair weather good breeze from S W
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack till 4 pm and tacked ship
the watch employed latter part to
repairing the fore top Galens sail saw
nothing so ends Lat 4 11 Long 57 38

Thursday June 11th the wind with
fair weather good breeze from S W Steered
by the wind on the Starboard tack
till 4 pm and tacked ship saw the
Island of Praxin at 11 am 40 miles
off watch employed variously Lat Long

Friday June 12th the wind with
fair weather good breeze from S W
steered by the wind on the Port tack
Praxin 35 miles off at sundown
saw Dennis Island at daylight the Capt
took the W B and J B in shore to trade
for Potatoes &c saw the John Dawson at 10 am
so ends

Saturday June 13th the wind with
fine weather good breeze from S W
the Capt came aboard at 4.30 pm with
14 Bags 180 lbs of Potatoes and 100 Coconuts
gave me the John Dawson from 5 till 9 pm
saw her again at daylight saw Dennis Island
15 miles off so ends Lat 3 25 Long 55 24

Sunday June 14th the wind with
fair weather good breeze from S W
steered by the wind on the Port tack
till 6 pm and were ship saw the John
Dawson at daylight watch employed fore
part Coopering the Butte so ends
Lat 3 27 Long 55 56 15
