tack strong breeze latter part from S E
with plain squalls saw nothing so ended
Lat 640 Long 6336

Friday July 17th begins with
strong breeze from S E with
squalls Steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack saw nothing but
Porpoises caught two so ended Lat 609 Long 6449

Saturday July 18th begins with
fresh breeze from S E Steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack til 6
Pm and tacked Ship the watch employed
variously saw nothing worthy of
remark so ended Lat 652 Long 6401

Sunday July 19th begins with
fresh breeze from S E Steered by the
wind on the Port tack til 6 Pm and
tacked Ship saw nothing so ended
Lat 746 Long 6353

Monday July 20th begins with
fresh breeze from S E by South
Steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack saw the Ship Almira of St Johns
N B went on board of her and got some
late papers so ended Lat 820 Long 6407

Tuesday July 21st begins with
strong breeze with squalls from S E
Steered by the wind on the Port tack
under double reefed top sails saw nothing
worthy of remark so ended Lat 1001 Long 6339

Wednesday July 22nd begins with
strong breeze from S E Steered
by the wind on the Port tack had
it more moderate latter part saw
nothing so ended Lat 1130 Long 6246

Thursday July 23rd begins with
fine weather fresh breeze from
S E Steered by the wind on the Port
tack til 6 Pm and tacked Ship
strong breeze latter part saw nothing
so ended Lat 1144 Long 6258

Friday July 24th begins with
strong breeze from South by
East Steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack til 10 Pm and wore
Ship saw nothing so ended Lat 1210 Long 6342
