Saturday July 25<sup>th</sup> begins with  
cloudy breeze from S.E. Steered by the  
wind on the Port tack more moderate  
latter part watch employed repairing the  
Main & top sail so ends Lat 18 52 Long 63 00

Sunday July 26<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather good breeze from S.E.  
Steered by the wind on the Port tack  
till 4 P.M. and tacked ship wind from S.W.  
latter part steady so ends Lat 18 52 Long 63 15

Monday July 27<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather good breeze from S.W.  
Steered by the wind on the Starboard  
tack wind from East latter part  
steered S.E. & watch employed getting  
out water from the fore & main  
so ends Lat 14 44 Long 63 53

Tuesday July 28<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fresh breeze from E by N & North  
Steered S.E. wind from E & N.E.  
latter part watch employed variously  
saw nothing so ends Lat 16 48 Long 63 57

Wednesday July 29<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair cloudy weather fresh breeze from  
E & S.E. Steered by the wind on the Port  
tack wind from S.E. latter part saw  
nothing worthy of remark there 24  
hours so ends Lat 18 40 Long 63 23

Thursday July 30<sup>th</sup> begins with  
fair weather fresh breeze from S.E.  
Steered by the wind on the Port tack  
till 7 P.M. and tacked ship tacked  
again at 5 A.M. saw one sail so ends  
Lat 19 08 Long 63 00

Friday July 31<sup>st</sup> begins with  
strong breeze from S.E. by South  
Steered by the wind on the Port tack  
had a moderate gale latter part  
watch employed repairing the fore  
top sail and bending the main latter part  
so ends Lat 19 55 Long 62 14

Saturday Aug 1<sup>st</sup> begins with  
a moderate gale from S.E. & S. Steered  
to on the Port tack till dark and  
wore ship had it more moderate  
latter part wore ship again at 6 A.M.  
saw nothing so ends Lat 19 50 Long 62 12

Sunday Aug 2<sup>nd</sup> begins with  
light or fair breeze from East Steered by  
the wind on the Port tack under  
short sail till 6 P.M. and wore ship  
saw a merchant ship steering about W by South  
so ends Lat 20 18 Long 62 05

Monday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> begins with  
strong breeze from East Steered by the  
wind on the Port tack till 6 P.M. and  
tacked ship fine weather latter part  
watch employed getting out the main  
stay sail and bending the same  
so ends Lat 19 30 Long 62 35
