Friday Aug 4th began with
fine weather fresh breeze from S.E. steered
by the wind on the Starboard tack till
6 Am and tacked ship fresh breeze latter
part so ends Lat 19 22 Long 62 38

Wednesday Aug 5th began with
fair weather fresh breeze from S.E. by
South steered by the wind on the Port
tack till 6 Pm and tacked ship wore ship
again at 7 Am saw nothing so ends Lat 19 25 Long 62 41

Thursday Aug 6th began with
fair weather fresh breeze from S.E.
steered by the wind on the Port tack till
6 Pm and tacked ship tacked again at
4 Am saw nothing so ends Lat 19 41 Long 62 32

Friday Aug 7th began with
fresh breeze from S.E. steered by the
wind on the Port tack till 6 Pm
and tacked ship wore from S.E. latter
part saw the Island of Rodriguez at day
light and one sail so ends Lat 19 25 Long 63 16

Saturday Aug 8th began with S.E.
fair weather fresh breeze from S.E.
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack till 3 Am and wore ship saw the
Island at daylight and one sail running
before the wind strong breeze latter part
so ends Lat 19 26 Long 63 24

Sunday Aug 9th began with
half a Gale from S.E. steered by the
wind on the Port tack till 4 Pm
and wore ship sailed within 12 miles
of the Land saw a ship at anchor wore
ship again at 4 Am saw no observation

Monday 10th began with
a moderate Gale from S.E. steered by
the wind on the Port tack till 6 Pm and wore
ship the Land 15 miles off at dark wore
ship again at 6 Am so ends none do

Tuesday Aug 11th began with
a moderate Gale from S.E. laid
hove to on the Port tack till 6 Pm and
wore ship the Land 18 miles off at dark
wore ship again at 6 Am saw the Land
all day so ends Lat none Long do

Wednesday Aug 12th began with
a moderate Gale from S.E. lay hove to on
the Port tack till 6 Pm and wore ship
the Land about 20 miles off at dark being
S.E. wore ship again at 6 Am saw
nothing so ends Lat 19 17 Long 62 57

Thursday Aug 13th began with
a moderate Gale from S.E. lay hove to on
the Port tack till 6 Pm and wore ship
saw Blackfish and porpoises going to windward
quick at 2 Pm had it wore moderate
latter part watch employed latter
part the day repairing the main sail
so ends Lat 19 24 Long 62 45
