Monday Sept 7th begins with
fresh breeze from SE sent the
Harboard Watch ashore on Liberty got two
Boat Loads of Wood got 3500 lbs of Potatoes and
1800 lbs of Yams sold one Bbl of Black fish
oil
So ends

Tuesday Sept 8th begins with
fresh breeze from SE sent the
Harboard Watch ashore on Liberty got two
Boat Loads of Wood from shore and stowed
it down below So ends

Wednesday Sept 9th begins with
fresh breeze from SE sent the
Harboard Watch ashore on Liberty got
two Boat Loads of Wood from shore and
stowed it down below So ends

Thursday Sept 10th begins with
fair weather from SE sent the Harboard
Watch ashore on Liberty got two Boat Loads
of Wood from shore So ends

Friday Sept 11th begins with
