top sail fair weather latter part the
day watch employed working on the boats
saw nothing so ends Lat 33 29 Long 71 57

Thursday Oct 15th Began with
fair weather light breeze from SW
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack shortened sail at dark and set
food boat to crew. Watched look for
from North latter part so ends Lat 33 38 Long 71 04

Friday Oct 16th Began with
fine weather light breeze from West steered
by the wind on the Starboard tack
shortened sail at dark and set
food boat to crew. Watched look for
from North latter part so ends Lat 34 Long 72 15

Tramping off shore of St Paul in Right Whales
Saturday Oct 17th Began with
fine weather light breeze from N.E. steered
by the wind on the Port tack shortened
sail at dark steered by the wind on the
Port tack latter part so ends Lat 34 Long

Sunday Oct 18th Began with
half a Gale from North side on the
Port tack under short sail had moderate
Gale latter part with some rain saw
two Finbacks so ends Lat 34 27

Monday Oct 19th Began with
strong breeze from NW had it foggy
and rainy laid by the wind on the
Port tack under close reefed top sail
more moderate latter part saw nothing
so ends no observation

Tuesday Oct 20th Began with
light breeze from NW with thick
foggy weather steered by the wind on
the Port tack shortened sail at dark
fine clear weather latter part saw four
or five Finbacks so ends Lat 33 12 Long 72 50

Wednesday Oct 21st Began with
fine weather light breeze from
NW steered by the wind on the
Port tack shortened sail at dark
steered by the wind on the Port tack
latter part saw nothing so ends Lat 33 10 Long 71 50
