

Black Bay, Frazier of New Bedford Capt. Cabwell
Sunday Nov 1st Begins with
fresh breeze from S.W. L.B. and B.B. went
in shore fishing got 3 or 4 shells fish. Come
on board at 6 P.M. and Steered North. Sailed
most all the fish latter part so ends Lat none

Monday Nov 2nd Begins with
fair weather good breeze from South
Steered North of our part calm all the latter
part watch employed latter part tending of the
fore top sail and ripping up the old top sail
so ends Lat 35 43 Long 76 50

Tuesday Nov 3rd Begins with
light breeze from S.W. Steered by
the wind on the Starboard tack with the
employed repairing the fore sail saw nothing
so ends Lat 35 16 Long 76 56

Wednesday Nov 4th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from N.E. Steered
by the wind on the Starboard tack at 4 P.M.
latter part tacked ship strong breeze latter part
the day watch employed latter part setting up
the Starboard Main rigging so ends Lat 34 24 Long 77 50

Thursday Nov 5th Begins with
strong breeze from West with some rain
and fog Steered N by E under short sail
fine weather latter part saw nothing
worthy of remark so ends Lat 32 51 Long 77 57

Friday Nov 6th Begins with
fine weather good breeze from West Steered
S by South Shortened sail at dark had a moderate
gale after part tacked hove to on the Port
tack under close reefed Main top sail
so ends no observation

Saturday Nov 7th Begins with
a moderate Gale from West and hove
to on the Port tack under close reefed
Main top sail fine weather latter part
but a heavy sea running wind from
South latter part so ends Lat 33 02 Long 78 47

Sunday Nov 8th Begins with
fine weather light breeze from South
Steered East Shortened sail at dark
wind from N.N.E. latter part saw nothing
worthy of remark so ends Lat 33 11 Long 78 40

Monday Nov 9th Begins with
fair weather good breeze from N.N.E.
Steered S by E Shortened sail at dark
Steered S.W. latter part the watch
employed making sword matts painting
the Whist Boat &c so ends Lat 32 58 Long 79 51

Tuesday Nov 10th Begins with
fine weather good breeze from North
Steered S.W. Shortened sail at dark
and Steered West strong breeze latter part
saw one Furback so ends Lat 35 07 Long 78 00
