 half a Gale from North Steered West
 by the wind on the Port tack saw nothing but
 two or three Finbacks so ends Lat 35 23 Long 76 28

Thursday Nov 12th Begins with
 fine weather light air from S W
 Steered by the wind on the Port tack
 saw nothing but Finbacks the watch
 employed at incidental duties so ends
 Lat 34 44 Long 75 30

Friday Nov 13th Begins with
 fine weather good breeze from S W
 Steered by the wind on the Port tack
 saw one sail the Duget of Marselles
 To Starboard Boat went on board of
 her for papers but got none wind from
 West latter part so ends Lat 33 13 Long 73 32

Saturday Nov 14th Begins with
 fine weather good breeze from East
 Steered West by South saw two Sulphur bottoms
 the watch employed working in the
 rigging so ends Lat 36 00 Long 71 40

Sunday Nov 15th Begins with
 fine weather good breeze from East
 Steered West by South wind from
 North latter part Steered West saw
 nothing so ends Lat 37 05 Long 68 46

Monday Nov 16th Begins with
 fair weather good breeze from West
 Steered by the wind on the Starboard
 tack wind from S W latter part watch
 employed putting a new cloth in the fore top sail
 so ends Lat 37 23 Long 67 47

Tuesday Nov 17th Begins with
 fine weather good breeze from S W Steered
 by the wind on the Port tack watch
 employed putting a new cloth into the fore
 top sail and sent it to the main at 4 PM watch
 employed latter part repairing the old fore
 top sail wind from N W backed Lat 37 00 Long 66 52

Wednesday Nov 18th Begins with
 fine weather good breeze from S W
 Steered by the wind on the Starboard
 tack watch employed repairing the
 old fore top sail a moderate Gale latter
 part latter so ends Lat 38 26 Long none

Thursday Nov 19th Begins with
 a Gale from N N W laid on the Starboard
 tack till 5 PM and wore ship saw a large
 English Troop Ship steering to the Eastward
 latter part so ends Lat 38 17 Long 65 06

Friday Nov 20th Begins with
 a moderate Gale from N W laid by the
 wind on the Port tack till 5 PM and wore
 ship wore ship again at 7 PM wore ship
 again at 7 PM saw two Finbacks
 so ends no observations
