fine weather Pleasant breeze from North
Steered West Strong breeze latter part
watch employed latter part repairing
an old Main Sail So ends Lat 38 18 Long 53 16

Wednesday Dec 2nd Begins with
Strong breeze from North Steered West
till dark wind hauled to W S W
half a Gale latter part saw one sail
So ends Lat 38 44 Long 54 55

Thursday Dec 3rd Begins with
a Gale from W S W and hove to
on the Starboard tack till 3 Pm
and wore ship a little more moderate
latter part So ends Lat 37 52 Long 54 25

Friday Dec 4th Begins with
Strong breeze from N S W Steered
by the wind on the Port tack
Wore ship the latter part from North
Steered West So ends no observations

Saturday Dec 5th Begins with
Strong breeze from N N E Steered W S W
at 15 Pm wore ship showing a stiff
Gale fair weather latter part with
the wind from W N W saw nothing
So ends Lat 38 48 Long 52 44

Sunday Dec 6th Begins with
fair fresh breeze from N W Steered
W S W a moderate Gale latter
part from West laid on the Starboard
tack So ends Lat 40 44 Long 53 10

Monday Dec 7th Begins with
a Gale from East on the Starboard
tack till 4 Pm and wore ship
half a Gale latter part saw one sail
So ends Lat more Long

Tuesday Dec 8th Begins with
fair weather wind from West Steered
by the wind on the Port tack
becalm all night a Gale latter part
from North Steered W S W So ends Lat more Long

Wednesday Dec 9th Begins with
a Stiff Gale from West hove to
on the Port tack under bare poles
a little more moderate latter part
saw nothing Lat 41 25 Long 54 04

Thursday Dec 10th Begins with
Strong breeze from W N W Steered
by the wind on the Starboard tack
wind from N E latter part Steered
West saw no sails So ends Lat 42 40 Long more
