Tuesday Jan 5th begins with
a Gale from WSW Calm on the
Port tack fine weather latter part
with the wind from NW Steered
by the wind on the Port tack saw
nothing so ends Lat 39.05 Long 44.35

Wednesday Jan 6th begins with
fair weather fresh breeze from
NNW Steered by the wind on the
Port tack till 6 PM and tacked Ship
till 8 PM of latter part from SW
so ends Lat 38.20 Long 48.24

Thursday Jan 7th begins with
a calm Calm with the sails clewed up
till 7 PM got a breeze from NE and
steered NW fresh breeze latter part
saw one sail so ends Lat 37.57 Long 41.31

Friday Thursday Jan 8th begins with
fair weather fresh breeze from NNE
steered by the wind on the Starboard
tack fresh breeze latter part from
SW Steered NW so ends Lat 36.02 Long 40.22

Saturday Jan 9th begins with
a calm Calm with the sails clewed
down till 2 AM got a breeze from NE
and steered NW the watch employed
working in the rigging saw nothing
so ends Lat 37.30 Long 39.37

Sunday Jan 10th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
ENE Steered by the wind on the
Starboard tack wind from SW the
latter part Steered NW saw nothing
so ends Lat 37.30 Long 37.49

Monday Jan 11th begins with
fine weather good breeze from SW
steered NW till it calm all night
good breeze latter part from NE saw
nothing so ends Lat 36.54 Long 36.15

Tuesday Jan 12th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
NE Steered NW till it calm
latter watch employed overhauling
lifts and footropes so ends Lat 36.46 Long none

Wednesday Jan 13th begins with
fair weather fresh breeze from South
steered NW till the wind from
ESE latter part watch employed
overhauling foot ropes and lifts
so ends Lat 36.05 Long 30.43

Thursday Jan 14th begins with
foggy weather fresh breeze from
ENE Steered NW the watch employed
working in the rigging saw nothing
so ends Lat 35.35 Long 27.40
