Monday Jan 25th begins with
fair weather fresh breeze from South
steered N N W strong breeze latter part
abundant steered North saw nothing
so ends Lat 28 42 Long 18 54

Tuesday Jan 26th begins with
strong breeze from South steered
N N E fine weather latter part
the watch employed working in the
rigging repairing the Bow Boat &c
Lat 28 13 Long 10 13

Wednesday Jan 27th begins with
fair weather good breeze from South
steered N E by North the watch
employed repairing an old Main top sail
and bending the same so ends Lat 28 00 Long 10 00

Thursday Jan 28th begins with
fine weather good breeze from South
steered N N E the watch employed
coopering carpentering working in the
rigging &c saw nothing so ends
Lat 22 30 Long 10 33

Friday Jan 29th begins with
fine weather good breeze from South
steered N E by North the watch employed
repairing the fore sail &c saw four or
five humpbacks so ends Lat 20 38 Long 10 35

Saturday Jan 30th begins with
fine weather good breeze from South
steered N E by North the watch
employed working in the rigging
saw nothing so ends Lat 18 53 Long 18 20

Sunday Jan 31st begins with
fine weather good breeze from
South steered W E by North fore
part steered E N E latter part saw nothing
so ends Lat 16 21 Long 11 21

Monday Feb 1st begins with
fine weather good breeze steered
E N E till dark sounded at 10
bottom at 85 fathoms steered W N E
at 11 Pm and hauled a back steered
E S E at daylight saw the Land at
5 Am so ends Lat 15 30 Long

Tuesday Feb 2nd begins with
fine weather light breeze from
about West steered down the
Land got into Little Fish Bay at
4 Pm come to anchor at 6 Pm off the
Isle this day contains only 12 hours so ends

Wednesday Feb 3rd begins with
fine weather light air from about West
sent the Watch ashore on Liberty the
Watch on board employed painting
Ship the Bark Linda Stewart sailed
at 3 Pm so ends this day
