Bark Mary Tracy of San Diego
Wednesday Feb 24th begins with
fine weather good breeze from S E
steered North saw Blackfish at
7 Am lowered 3 boats but did not
strike so ends Lat 6 20 Long 10 32

Thursday Feb 25th begins with
fine weather good breeze from S E
steered North had it some squally
latter part the day saw nothing
so ends Lat 4 58 Long 11 14

Friday Feb 26th begins with
fine weather good breeze from
S E steered North watch employed
variously saw Grampuses and porpoises
so ends Lat 3 25 Long 11 50

Saturday Feb 27th begins with
fine weather light breeze from S E
steered North had it raining
the latter part saw some Grampuses
so ends Lat none Long

Sunday Feb 28th begins with
rainy squalls from West steered
North fine weather latter part
saw Blackfish at 11 30 Am lowered
three boats so ends Lat 1 42 Long 12 30

Bound to the Western Ground
Monday March 1st begins with
fine weather light breeze from
S W steered North S E and S W
got a Blackfish each at 18 Am saw
more at 8 Am so ends Lat 00 55 Long 13 02

Tuesday March 2nd begins with
fine weather good breeze from S W
steered N N W saw Blackfish at
3 Am no boat lowered saw them again
at 10 Am steered N W latter part
so ends Lat 00 09 South Long 14 07

Wednesday March 3rd begins with
fine weather good breeze from
S W steered N N W saw Blackfish
at 2 Am and at 6 Am lowered 3 boats
at 6 Am did not strike rain and
squally latter part so ends Lat 01 00 Long 14 53

Thursday March 4th begins with
fine weather good breeze from W N W
steered by the wind on the Port tack
had it squally and rainy latter part
saw nothing so ends Lat none Long

Friday March 5th begins with
squally rainy weather light breeze
from West steered by the wind
on the Port tack saw Blackfish
the latter part so ends Lat 03 27 Long none
